The Randall Museum sits within the beautiful Corona Heights Park. Here you can witness some of the best San Francisco vistas, discover many walking trails surrounded by lush vegetation, and hike to the top of "The Corona."

Randall Museum

The Randall Museum is a museum of science, nature and the arts as well as a San Francisco Recreation and Park Department community learning center. The museum has engaging activities for visitors of all ages, including live animal encounters, drop-in activities, and a large variety of classes.

The Randall Museum opened in its current location in 1951 by San Francisco's first Superintendent of Recreation, Josephine Randall. The museum was named in her honor in recognition of the 12 million dollar bond that she shepherded for nature education. In 2004 the outdoor grounds were renovated, and in 2017 the interior was redesigned and revitalized to better serve the community.
